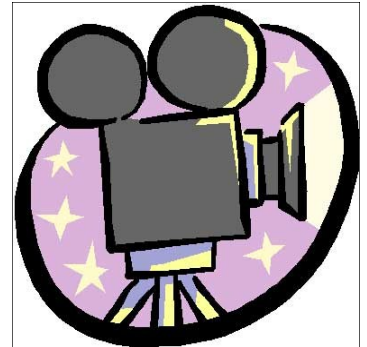


Happy 2019 SSD Family
